## COOPERATION PARTNERSHIP IN ADULT EDUCATION

We are gladly announcing that our KA2 project **Need for Lead** started! We designed this project aiming to address the needs of people with disabilities and their families, when it comes to mental health post COVID-19 pandemic.

It is well known that the pandemic had severe and long-lasting consequences around the globe, which are further aggravated for marginalized groups, people with disabilities, especially parents and families of these vulnerable persons. As a result, during and after lockdowns in different countries, family members of people with disabilities had, and in some situations still have, to quit their jobs and stay home, to be able to take care of the vulnerable relatives, or to protect them from Covid19.

**Need for Lead** project has two purposes:

1. To develop a Guide (Methodology) of mental adaptation of family members of the disadvantaged groups - we will create a space for new knowledge and abilities for the social and community workers, volunteers, educators. Based on this guide, we will train local mentors that will further host pilot activities in each partner country with people with disabilities and their families.
2. To increase the skills on online professional development for the families of the vulnerable groups/the beneficiaries with disabilities themselves. This will consist in training the beneficiaries of the project on increasing their digital skills and use the online environment to find professions and work online.

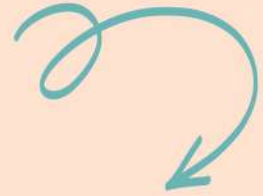
## KICK-OFF MEETING
