We strongly think that this meeting has been a key activity to improve all the quality and workflow of Need for Lead.

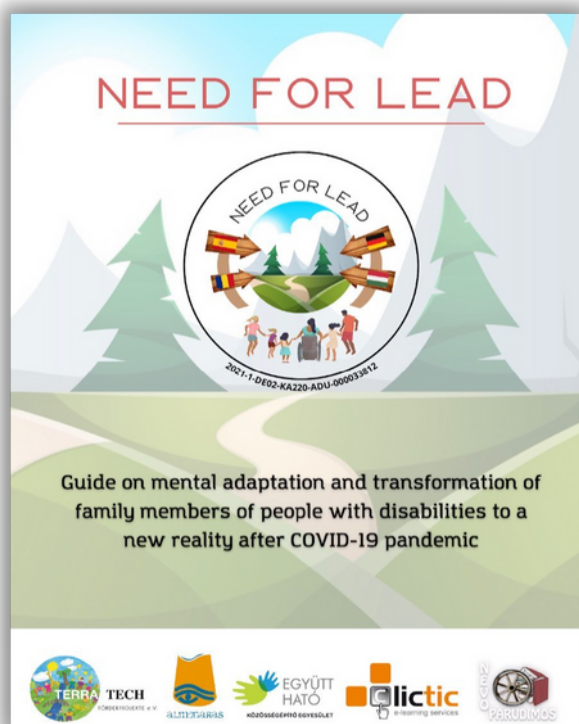

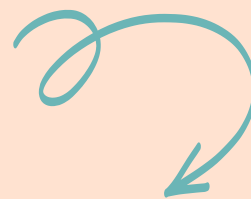
